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LEHB Eligibility Policy Regarding Newborns

LEHB's policy regarding dependent children having newborns is as follows:

- LEHB is responsible for the dependent's full maternity coverage for all eligible medical services.
- The dependent's newborn (LEHB member's grandchild) is a non eligible dependent on the LEHB policy and coverage will only be provided for the newborn until the dependent mother is discharged from the hospital.

LEHB is a self-insured health and welfare fund. We are not subject to the mandated 30 days of medical coverage for a newborn.

LEHB makes all families, with dependents of childbearing years, aware of this policy by postcard every three months. Additionally, this information is posted on our website. www.lehb.org

LEHB is financially responsible for all newborn eligible services including Nursery Services for as long as the birth mother remains in the hospital. Once the birth mother is discharged, LEHB coverage for the newborn will terminate.
