MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES

➤ Philadelphia Autism Center for Excellence (PACE):

NET is one of only three agencies designated by Community Behavioral Health as a Philadelphia Autism Center for Excellence (PACE). PACE includes an array of services for children diagnosed with an Autism Spectrum Disorder and their families, including diagnostic and level of care evaluations, outpatient services and social skills groups, autism specific behavioral consultation, mobile therapy, and one-to-one behavioral support through Behavioral Health Rehabilitation Services (BHRS) after-school and summer therapeutic programming, resource connection (BCM), and parent training.

➤ Outpatient Mental Health Services (MHOP)

Therapists provide both individual and family therapy and, if needed, psychiatric assessment and medication management. Specialized treatment is offered for youth and adults who have experienced abuse, neglect, violence and other traumatic life events. Our staff are also trained to provide evidence-based trauma treatment to children between the ages of 2 and 5 as well as their parents and caregivers.

➤ School-Based Therapeutic Services (STS)

Group and individual therapy as well as individual and group behavioral support is provided to students in the public or charter school setting. Students are referred by their home school. NET provides these behavioral health services in the following Philadelphia elementary and middle

schools: Dunbar, Ludlow, DeBurgoss, Juniata Park Academy (JPA), Ben Franklin, Stearne, and Southwark.

Referrals are made directly through the schools.

➤ *Behavioral Health Rehabilitation Services (BHRS)*

Also referred to as “wraparound”, BHRS services are provided to children whose behavior is seriously impacting their ability to function well in the home, school and community setting. An assessment is done to determine what services are needed and to determine that the youth’s needs cannot be met in an outpatient setting. Services consist of individualized levels of behavioral consultation, mobile therapy, and goal- directed one-to-one behavior support.

➤ *Family-Based Mental Health (FBS)*

A team-based approach in which clinicians specializing in family systems treatment provide intensive behavioral health treatment and case management support to all members of the family. The services are provided in the home, school, and community settings. The family-based program focuses on the family as a system and how the system affects the child experiencing behavioral challenges. NET FBS has a Spanish speaking team and two teams that work with children identified with Developmental Disability.
